### CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT TIMES

Lodging should be available for check-in at 4 p.m. However, immediate availability cannot be guaranteed. Check-out time is 11 a.m. All housekeeping and maintenance is done from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Please plan your arrival and departure accordingly. Please store your perishable food items properly, since the park does not have facilities for public storage.

### PARK ENTRY PERMITS

Valid park entry permits are required for all vehicles entering the park. **Permits must be affixed to the lower left corner of the windshield.** Permits can be purchased on arrival. Permits are valid statewide for all Game and Parks Commission park areas.

### REFUND & CANCELLATION GUIDELINES

Your reservation may be cancelled at your request, as stipulated below, or for non-payment by the date required. The \$7 reservation fee per unit is not refundable. Cancellation requests may be made online or by contacting Mahoney SP. For questions or to cancel your reservation, email us at [ngpc.mahoney.reservations@nebraska.gov](mailto:ngpc.mahoney.reservations@nebraska.gov). When a reservation is made, no changes to the arrival date are allowed. Guests are not allowed to cancel any days from the beginning of their original arrival date or transfer their arrival date to a later date within the existing reservation dates. If you check out early, the unused portion of your payment will be forfeited.

### Cabins / Lodge Rooms

- 0 - 29 days prior to arrival date - refund granted minus 1 night's rental per unit being cancelled plus cancellation fee of \$5 per unit cancelled
- 30 days or more prior to arrival date - refund granted minus cancellation fee of \$5 per unit cancelled

### FRONT DESK

The front desk at Peter Kiewit Lodge is staffed 24 hours a day. All cabin and lodge room check-ins are handled at the front desk, as well as reservations for future visits. The Peter Kiewit Lodge also houses the restaurant, gift shop and conference facilities.

### DAMAGE WAIVER

Waiver must be signed by an individual 18 years of age or older. Key will not be issued to anyone under the age of 18. Guests are responsible for any damage or excessive soiling of lodging facilities and will be billed accordingly. Adults signing for minor children will be held responsible for all activities or damages occurring within the facility.

### HOUSEKEEPING

Routine housekeeping will be done after your departure. If you need clean linens during your stay, please bring soiled linens to the Peter Kiewit Lodge front desk. Clean linens will be exchanged or delivered to your cabin. Peter Kiewit Lodge guest rooms receive fresh towels daily.

### PETS

Pets are allowed but must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet at all times. There is a \$15 one-time pet fee per unit for pets staying in cabins. Service animals are exempt. Pets may not be left unattended in the cabins. Any repair for damage to lodging facilities or extra cleaning related to pets will be billed to the person who signed the damage waiver. Pets are not allowed in the Peter Kiewit Lodge or any public building.

### PARKING

Parking spaces are provided for cabin and lodge guests but are not reserved. Overflow parking areas adjoin each cabin area for use by your visiting guests. Please be courteous to others and encourage use of these areas. Parking along the curb within the cabin loops is strongly discouraged, since there is no designated parking along the roadways.

### ITEMS PROVIDED

Cabins are equipped with towels, bed linens, a small assortment of cooking and dining utensils, hand and dishwashing soaps, satellite TV, coffee maker, toaster, microwave, small stove and refrigerator. Bed linens for sofa sleepers and Murphy beds are stored in a drawer in one of the bedrooms.

### FIREPLACES

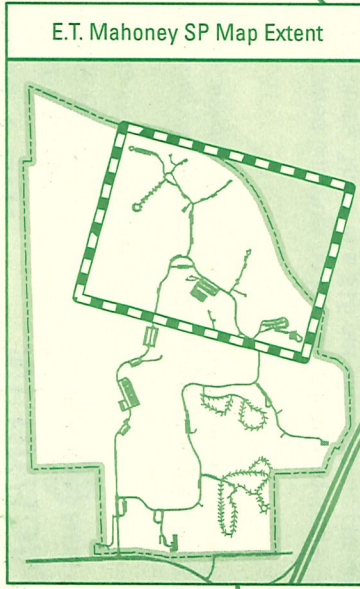
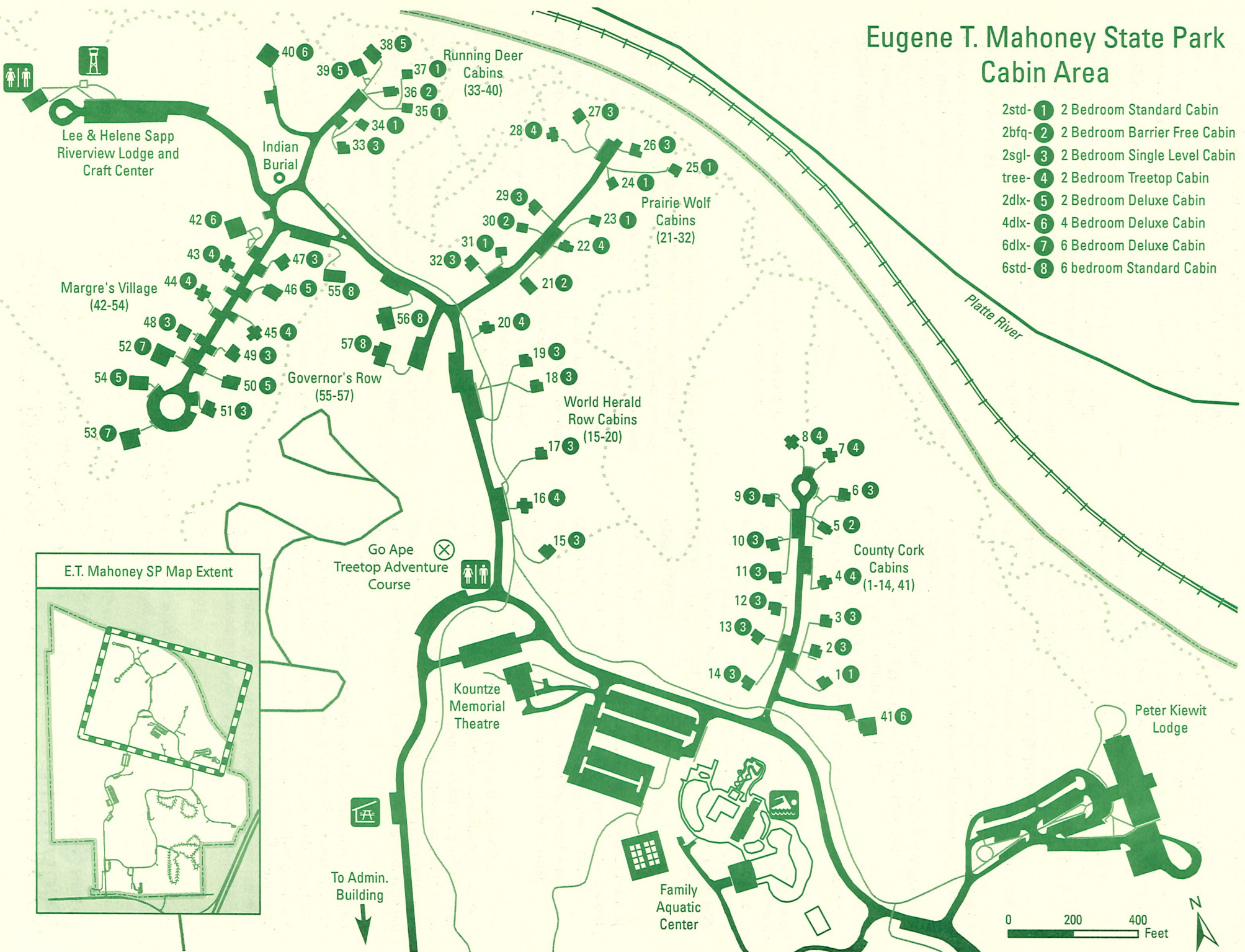
Fireplaces may be operated Oct. 1-April 30, but dates may vary with weather conditions. Firewood and Duraflame logs may be purchased at Kiewit Lodge. Please do not burn trash, damp wood, or pine type wood, since these cause soot to build up in the chimney. Be careful when stoking logs or storing hot pokers to prevent damage to carpets and trim.

### OTHER INFORMATION

- Alcohol consumption is prohibited after 10 p.m. or where prohibited by signs.
- Fireworks are prohibited in the park.
- Quiet hours are in effect from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Tent or RV camping is allowed only on the established campgrounds.
- A visitor services guide is available on arrival or will be mailed on request. It covers activities, times, fees, location, etc. After mid-August activity hours depend on staff availability.

- Off-season lodging discounts are available from Oct. 1 - April 30. A 30% discount applies from Sunday through Thursday stays during non-holiday periods.

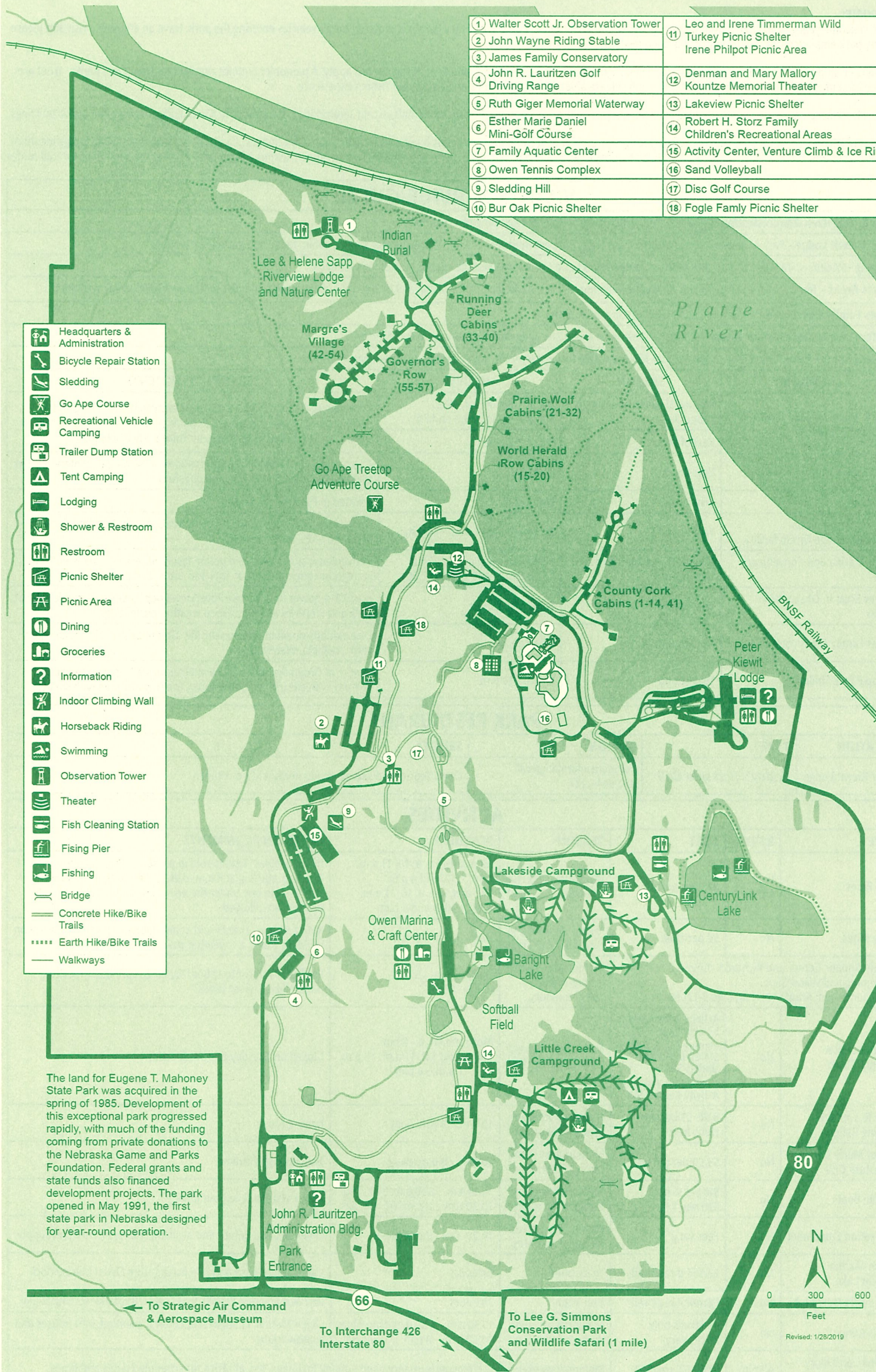

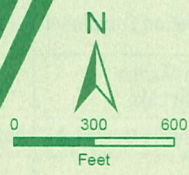
The land for Eugene T. Mahoney State Park was acquired in the spring of 1985. Development of this exceptional park progressed rapidly, with much of the funding coming from private donations to the Nebraska Game and Parks Foundation. Federal grants and state funds also financed development projects. The park opened in May 1991, the first state park in Nebraska designed for year-round operation.

**LODGE ROOM / CABIN SETUPS AND SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS**  
 (See other side for rates.)

**LODGE** – All rooms are equipped with satellite TV, telephone, coffee pot, mini refrigerator, microwave and wireless internet. Even-numbered rooms have a river view; odd numbers, park view. Room assignments at discretion of park staff.

**STANDARD ROOM** – Ground and main level rooms have two queen-sized beds.

**LOFT ROOM #201-216** – Top level rooms are equipped with two queen beds, one queen sofa sleeper and electric fireplace.

**CABINS** – All cabins have a wood burning fireplace, deck, kitchenette, microwave, coffee pot, toaster, satellite TV, grill, picnic table, bed linens, and towels. All but 8 have two bedrooms.

**STANDARD TWO-BEDROOM** – Two queen-sized beds and a Murphy bed. Sleeps 6.

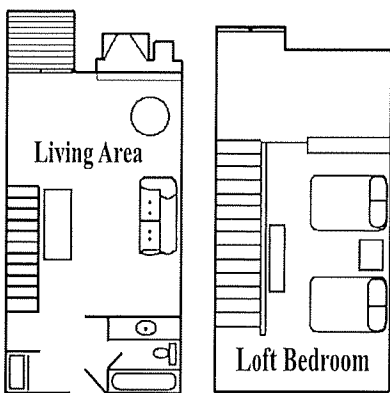
**STANDARD SIX-BEDROOM** – One king-size bed and five queen-sized beds. Sleeps 12.

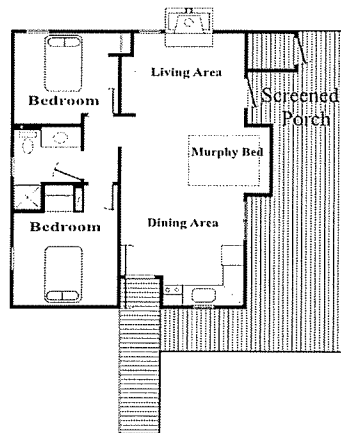
**EXTRA BEDS** – One roll-away or one crib is allowed per cabin at a cost of \$15 each per night. Sorry, no roll-aways are allowed in the lodge rooms.

**DELUXE SIX-BEDROOM** – Five king-sized beds, two sets of bunk beds with double beds on the bottom of bunks, one queen-sized sofa sleeper and one Murphy bed. Sleeps 16 – 20.

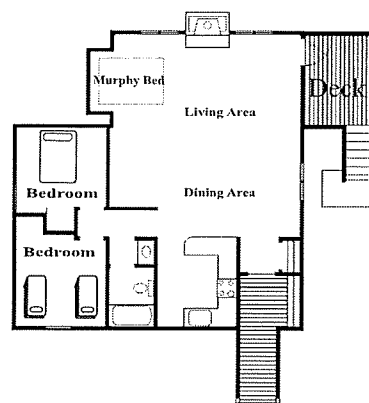
**LOFT LODGE ROOM**



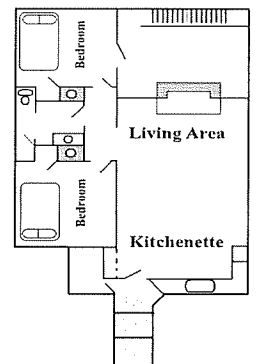
**STANDARD CABIN**



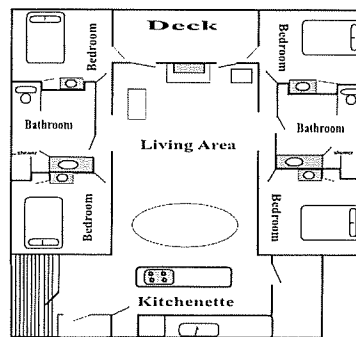
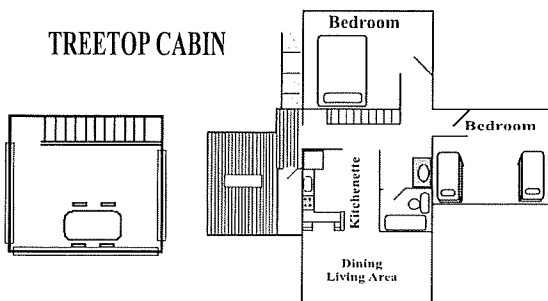
**SINGLE-LEVEL CABIN**



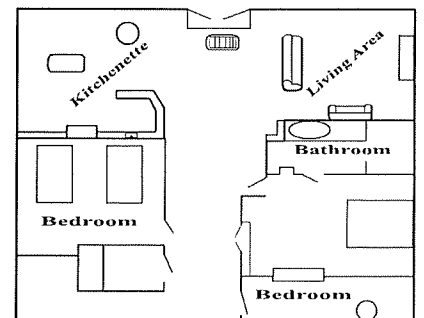
**TWO - BEDROOM DELUXE CABIN**

### RESERVATION GUIDELINES

- Reservations are accepted up to one year in advance of your arrival date for lodging, camping, and other facilities.
- Year to date reservations are accepted daily, year-round beginning at 9 a.m. Central Time online, by phone, or in person at the above address.
- An \$8.50 non-refundable reservation fee per lodging unit, campsite or facility is applied to every reservation.

### MINIMUM STAYS

#### Campsites

- Weekends require a 2-night minimum stay
- Holidays require a 3-night minimum stay
- Camping or occupying locations within a park area or campground is permitted for a maximum of 14 consecutive days during any 30-day period, except for designated extended stay campsites or by approval of park superintendent.

#### Cabin / Lodge Rooms

- Peak-season requires a 2-night minimum stay (1-night reservations are accepted when the one night is only available between reservations). Units may be rented for 1 night on a walk-in, first come, first served basis the day of your stay, if available.
- Off-season does not require a minimum stay Sunday through Thursday nights (1-night reservations are accepted excluding weekend and holiday stays).

### PAYMENT PROCEDURES

- Payment in full is required by Visa, MasterCard or Discover at the time the reservation is made.
- If payment cannot be made by Visa, MasterCard or Discover, it may be accepted as check, money order or cash within 10 calendar days of booking the reservation (must be made more than 30 days ahead of arrival to apply). If payment in full is not received under those guidelines, the reservation will be cancelled.

### CANCELLATION GUIDELINES

Facilities available 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. on the date specified.
